ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must have a 2007-08 USBC membership card or receipt. Non-members may qualify by purchasing memberships for \$20.00 or by paying a participation fee of \$5.00.

All entrants MUST have bowled a actual 600 series in a USBC sanctioned league or tournament.

AVERAGES

Highest Standard or Adjusted Sport League Average shall be used.

All entrants will use their highest 2006-07 winter average, based on a minimum of 21 games. Bowlers not having an established 2006-07 winter average, may use their highest 2007 spring /summer average.

Bowlers with no previous season's average shall use their current average (12 games or more) as of the first date of bowling (Oct 20th). Bring verification of average. All others will bowl scratch (210).

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler or others.

If the submitted average is lower than required and results in more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified.

If submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.

10 pin average increase rule is **NOT** in effect.

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Handicap will be 90% of 210 with no limit.

PARTICIPATION

Bowlers may only bowl each event only once.
