ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must have a 2009-10 USBC membership card or receipt. Non-members may qualify by purchasing memberships for \$20.00 or by paying a participation fee of \$5.00.

All entrants MUST have bowled an actual 600 series in a USBC sanctioned league or tournament.

AVERAGES

Highest Standard or Adjusted Sport League Average shall be used.

All entrants will use their highest 2008-09 winter average, based on a minimum of 21 games. Bowlers not having an established 2008-09 winter average must use their highest 2009 spring /summer average.

Bowlers with no previous season's average shall use their current average (12 games or more) as of the first date of bowling (Oct 17th). Please bring verification of average at time of bowling. All others will bowl scratch (210).

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler or others. If the submitted average is lower results in more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If submitted average is higher prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of a series.

Rule 319a(2), 319c, 319d, 319e will NOT be in effect.

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Handicap will be 90% of 210 with no limit.

PARTICIPATION

Bowlers may bowl each event once.
