

## Minnesota State USBC Scholarship Application

Dear Parent, Association Official, School Official or MN State USBC Youth Coach:

Attached you will find a scholarship application for scholarships to be awarded by the Minnesota State USBC Bowling Association. At least 4 scholarships (two boys, two girls) will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00.

## **ELIGIBILITY RULES**

Any graduating high school senior is eligible to receive a scholarship, providing the student meets the following requirements:

- A. The recipient must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited secondary learning institution. (This includes any public or private university, junior or state college, technical institute or any specialized trade school.)
- B. Is a current member of a Minnesota USBC certified youth bowling league and is in good standing.
- C. Has unimpaired amateur standing in all athletics.

Scholarships will be held in an escrow account. Each scholarship is valid until the recipient's 21<sup>st</sup> birthday. Scholarship money must be paid directly to the school of the recipient's choice after enrollment has been confirmed. Scholarship winners should contact the MN State USBC office to request payment of scholarship money. Scholarship money not used will return to the scholarship fund.

Recipients will be notified in July. Certificate presentations of the award will be made in August at the Banquet of Champions. Scholarship winners are asked to attend the Banquet of Champions and give a short acceptance speech.

In addition to the complete application, the following information <u>must</u> be submitted.

- 1. Copy of high school transcripts.
- 2. Two (2) letters of recommendation from a teach, a coach or state/local MN State USBC youth association official.
- 3. In the form of an essay (200 words, typewritten) explain your future goals for bowling, your college choice, future career plans and how bowling will help you achieve those goals.
