A candidate for the board must be:

3. <u>To be eligible for election to Vice President or Sergeant-at-Arms, a person must have served as a</u> <u>Director or Officer on the MN USBC Board of Directors.</u> To be eligible for election to President, a <u>person must have served as a Director or Officer on the MN USBC Board of Directors for a minimum of</u> <u>two years immediately preceding the date said person would begin term if elected.</u>

*Reason for addition: To help with succession planning, the person coming in as President needs to be aware of all current business being conducted and the processes involved.*
